Catholic Cemeteries, Diocese of Springfield in Illinois Burial Easement / Interment Contract Instructions and Sample

Use: The Burial Easement/Interment Contract is used when a person is purchasing graves, crypts or niches. It is also used when a person is contracting an interment (the opening and closing of a grave and/or additional interment rites).

Directions:

- 1. The name and city of the cemetery where the graves/crypts/niches are being purchased or where the burial is going to occur.
- 2. For parish cemeteries: include the name of the Pastor/Parochial Administrator/Parish Life Coordinator. For regional cemeteries and Catholic cemeteries associations: include the name of the Cemetery Manager.
- 3. Contact information for either the parish office or the cemetery office.
- 4. Name and contact information for the person(s) purchasing graves/crypts/niches and/or an interment.
- 5. This section is only used when purchasing graves/crypts/niches:
 - a. The total number of interment rites being purchased. Generally, this would be one rite per grave.
 - b. Include the name of the cemetery where the purchased space is located.
 - c. The contract must include a detailed description of the space that is being purchased. This includes information about the section, block, lot and grave(s) for burials and crypt, niche(s) and tier for inurnments.
- 6. This section should only be used if purchasing a grave and should include the following:
 - a. The total number of grave(s) purchased; the cost of 1 grave; the income care for the number of graves purchased; and a subtotal of these amounts.
- 7. This section should only be used if purchasing a crypt/niche and should include the following:
 - a. Total number of crypt(s) or niche(s) purchased; the cost per crypt(s)/niche(s); the income care for the number of crypts/niches purchased; and a subtotal of these amounts.
- 8. This section should be used only if an interment is going to occur immediately. If a person is purchasing graves/crypts/niches pre-need, leave this section blank. This section should include the following:
 - a. The number of interments; the cost per interment; and a subtotal of these amounts.
- 9. An inscription fee is used when a cemetery charges to inscribe information on an existing tombstone or for a niche inscription. If your cemetery does not offer this service, leave this section blank.
- 10. This section should include any additional items that the consumer is paying for that is not included elsewhere in the contract. For example, if a cemetery allows for multiple burials and charges for additional interment rites, that amount should be listed in this section.
- 11. This line can be used if a payment is received from a funeral home or insurance company for full or partial payment for the purchase a grave/crypt/niche and/or an interment. This amount should be subtracted from the total.

- 12. The total amount due for the services being purchased.
- 13. Cemeteries must accept at least one other form of payment besides cash, i.e. personal check or credit card. Use this section to record payment information.
- 14. The notes section can include any additional information or special circumstances that need to be included in the contract. Some examples are:
 - a. John Doe purchases four graves and he would like to designate who is to be buried in each grave.
 - b. Someone is purchasing an irregular grave that cannot be used for a traditional burial. The notes section can designate that the purchased space can only be used for cremated remains.
 - c. Anything that is an exception to normal cemetery rules. For example, the cemetery allows above ground markers, but for a particular section it only allows a flat marker.
- 15. This section must be signed by the person purchasing the graves/crypts/niches and/or contracting for an interment. For parish cemeteries the contract **must** be signed by the Pastor/Parochial Administrator/Parish Life Coordinator. For regional cemeteries and Catholic cemeteries associations the contract **must** be signed by the Cemetery Manager.
