Stewardship

What is it?

Stewardship is not fundraising...and a school should be doing both.

Stewardship is a great spiritual practice to teach students:

Pray. Serve. Give.

They already do stewardship, we just aren't calling it that.

Why?

Don't children have enough to learn?!

Not just an "adult" thing or service project

Consumerism and materialistic culture

Kids receive 3,000 ad messages a day (including those now being imbedded into movies and television.) By the time they are 21 they will have received 23 million advertising messages.

Stewardship can help build self-esteem

Stewardship teaches the difference between needs and wants: holiness and happiness

Teaches kids to act on their faith and share their faith: ie. witness testimonials

Stewardship is a spiritual practice for discipleship making.



Stewardship

Why is it important for my community to teach children about stewardship?

Evangelize the parents

Encourage future faith participation

Normalizes the behavior

Opportunities for news (new ideas, kids doing service, giving days,etc.)

Bridges current parishioners with school/PSR families

Multi-generational discipleship making

Stewardship Anchors for Kids

Prayer	 Mass Intentions, Class Prayer, Online wall
Service	 Coordinate with Parish Ministries
Giving	 Provide envelopes, School Mass Sundays
Acknowledgement	 Kids TY's to each other, Ministries, Donors
Witness	Teacher Stories, Recent Alumni

Challenges to Teaching Stewardship

Lack of support from parents

Don't feel comfortable talking about "money" with students

Lack of knowledge on stewardship from volunteers teaching PSR/School

Lack of resources for multitude of ages, backgrounds, denominations



Collaboration Is Key!

Leveraging Your Community to Children's Stewardship

Stop the Silos!

Children's opportunity as grantor

- Let kids select a charity which will be the recipient of their gifts.
- Designate how offertory gifts will be used

New Family Communications

Children present as witness during your annual Season of Stewardship

Introducing Children's Envelopes

Communicate it is NOT another fundraiser!

Distribution of envelopes weekly/monthly as opposed to once/year- Utilize your bulletin co.

Utilize examples for witness in bulletin

Might need to rethink Offertory!

Design own envelope in Art! Change based on age- OSV

Don't forget the TY! (Post-card)

Do you tithe?

This is anonymous;)



Teaching the Tithe

Upper Grades

Remind them what tithe is and how Jesus challenged us further

Tithe can work in many ways outside of money: Toys in room, favorite hobby, sharing with siblings, etc.

10% of an hour= 6 min.

Work from an allowance chart:

\$1 allowance - 10 pennies back to God; \$2 - 2 dimes; \$5 - 2 quarters, etc.

Presenting Stewardship

- Give = Bday Gifts

- Widow's Contribution (Mark 12: 41)
